

Chromebook Rental Agreement

Dear Parents / Carers,

As a condition of enrolment at the College for Years 7-9, all students must participate in the Chromebook rental program, which is essential to the delivery of the Year 7-9 curriculum.

To ensure your child's participation in the program, please complete and sign the College Chromebook Rental Agreement below and the accompanying Student ICT Policy Agreement.

Terms of Agreement

1. Bayside Christian College will rent the Chromebook to the parent/carer
2. The rental agreement will commence when the laptop is collected from the College and will continue until the student completes Year 9 or ceases to be enrolled at the college.
3. Rental payments will be incorporated into the school fee statements. This must be paid by parents on the due date as stipulated on the fee statement.
4. The Chromebook must be returned to Bayside Christian College in good working order with all accessories (i.e. case, power adaptor, etc.). A full refund of the enrolment bond will not be paid to departing families if the Chromebook is not returned to the College; or, the Chromebook is determined to have malicious or intentional damage not covered by warranty or the accidental damage protection insurance policy.

Obligations of Bayside Christian College

The College will:

- (a) keep the Chromebook insured against loss or damage as a result of theft or accidental damage (loss due to negligence excluded), provided that the parent/carer and student have complied with this Agreement and the Chromebook Program Policy Agreement.

- (b) maintain, repair, or replace the Chromebook as required provided that the parent has complied with this Agreement and the Chromebook Program Policy Agreement.

Parent / Carer Obligations

The parent / carer acknowledges that:

- (a) no title or rights of ownership of the Chromebook passes to the parent or the student by reason of this Agreement or the possession of the Chromebook;
- (b) the College may perform maintenance on the Chromebook and remove content stored on the Chromebook at any time. Students should always store files or data they need in Google Drive.
- (c) the child and parent hold full responsibility for their device and will not hold Bayside Christian College liable for any breakages, vandalism, or loss of device (or included accessories) that occur through misuse, abuse, or neglect of the Chromebook.

The parent / carer will:

- (a) only permit the Chromebook to be used:
- at the College;
 - at the home of the student;
 - when the student is travelling to and from the College; and at other locations approved by the parent / carer.
- (b) ensure the Chromebook is kept in good working order and condition.
- (c) immediately notify the College of any damage to; or loss or theft of, the Chromebook;
- (d) pay up to a maximum \$500.00, for any loss or damage to the Chromebook incurred by the College as a result of the warranty, insurance policy or maintenance agreement becoming null and void due to:
- failure to comply with this agreement;
 - deliberate or malicious damage to the computer;
 - negligence on the part of the parent / carer or student.
- (e) return the Chromebook to the College when requested to do so for the purpose of maintenance or to allow the computer to be inspected by the College.
- (f) At the end of the rental agreement will:
- ensure all accessories and components are returned with the Chromebook, including the carry bag, power adaptor, and other items issued with the Chromebook at any time during the rental period,
 - ensure the Chromebook external casing, keyboard, ports and screen are all in good repair, notwithstanding reasonable wear and tear.
- (g) return the computer in good working order to the College immediately:

- at the end of the Agreement when the student completes Year 9;
- when the Agreement has been terminated by the College; or
- when the student ceases to be enrolled at the College.

Termination of Rental Agreement

1. The College may end this Agreement if the parent / carer defaults on the terms of the Agreement and the default continues for more than 30 days after a notice of default in writing is given by the College to the parent / carer.
2. If a student ceases enrolment at the College before the Agreement period ends the Chromebook must be returned to the College.
