

Student ICT Policy Agreement

Computer and Internet Use

I have read the Bayside Christian College Computer and Internet Acceptable Use Policy for students and agree to abide by this policy.

I agree to take good care of any Bayside Christian College ICT equipment that I use and to use all devices in an appropriate manner for educational purposes. I agree to only use an account or login on the College network that is my own issued by the College or the local user account on my chosen device for BYOD.

I understand that the College monitors all Internet and computer use on the College network. Any attempt to circumvent the College network policies, including web filtering; or, to put at risk the security of the College network, will be considered a breach of this agreement, and appropriate disciplinary actions will be taken by the College.

The consequence of breaching the College ICT policies may include the College limiting my access to computer facilities and/or loss of my Internet and email access for some time, and I may also incur other appropriate disciplinary action at the discretion of the College Leadership. Any serious and unlawful actions using the College network or Internet facilities will result in police notification of my actions.

Bayside Christian College is committed to helping students learn how to be smart, safe and responsible online. It is an expectation that you will C.A.R.E. (Care for and Respect Everyone) when you are online.

If you ever have any concerns about your online safety, please speak to your teacher(s), our Chaplain, or the ICT Manager.

Parent ICT Policy Agreement

As a Parent/Guardian of a student at Bayside Christian College we require you to accept the Policies we have provided to ensure the safety of your child and other students at the College. We also ask you to take your part as a parent to support these policies and to help educate your child in the area of technology and the safe use of the internet (Cyber Safety).

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- Talk to your child/ren about the values and standards they should follow when using the Internet and online apps and services just as you would on the use of all other media sources such as television, mobiles, movies, or radio programs.
- Understand that the child and parents hold full responsibility for any BYOD devices used at the College and will not hold Bayside Christian College liable for any breakages, vandalism or loss of device that occur outside of the College or due to their misuse or abuse of the device while at the College.
- Understand that students may not use any social media sites such as Facebook, Twitter, Tumblr, Snapchat, Instagram, etc at the school on their device or any College-owned device.
- Understand that accessing inappropriate material on a student or College-owned device is grounds for disciplinary action, which may include being banned from participation in the BYOD program and/or having network privileges taken away for an appropriate time depending on the severity of the infraction.

Student BYOD Program

When participating in the College BYOD program, I understand that web filtering will be in use on the BYOD WiFi network on my device only while I am at the College (not at home), and I will comply with all College ICT policies when using a BYOD device on campus, including the Student BYOD Policy.

Student Responsibilities for BYOD Program

- I will follow the policies outlined in the Bayside Christian College Student BYOD Policy manual.
- I will always use my BYOD device in ways that are appropriate, educational, and meet Bayside Christian College's policies and expectations, while using the College network.
- I understand that my BYOD device is subject to inspection at any time by a Teacher or the ICT Department staff.
- I will be responsible for all damage or loss of my device that is caused by my neglect or abuse while it is used at the College.
- I will not install or use any apps or services designed to circumvent the College web filter, including VPNs, proxies, or remote access apps. I understand that I will receive disciplinary action for violations of this policy including the suspension of my College network accounts and removal of my device from the College network.

I understand that the Internet can connect me to much useful information stored on computers around the world. While I am connected to the Internet on the College network:

- I will use it only for educational purposes,
- I will not search or look for anything that is illegal, dangerous or offensive online,
- If I accidentally come across something that is illegal, dangerous or offensive, I will:
 - ✓ clear any offensive pictures or information from my screen or ICT devices and then immediately and quietly inform my Teacher.
 - ✓ I will not use any online apps, sites, services, or email to annoy, offend, or otherwise harass anyone else.
